Veterinarian Maine Emergency Assoc. New Gloucester, ME 782-8318 General Rules: 1. Every class recognized by the Maine Horse Association will be conducted and judged under the current rules of MHA. Six ribbons in all classes, trophy/money as indicated. 2. Show Ring is Sand Ring (indoor with rubber/sand footing if inclement weather) 3. NO DOGS PLEASE 4. No horse may enter a class until an entry blank has been completed, fees paid and number assigned. Management has the right to decline an entry without liability.

5. To be eligible for Stake Classes, horse must have entered and shown in its respective over fence class. Championship classes: to be eligible rider/horse must be entered, shown, judged in class indicated in parentheses (). 6. Entry fees: \$15; \$20 stake, medal, derby, championship classes. MHA \$4 trophy fee per horse/pony. Entries received or postmarked past 5/30, 9/5 will be charged a \$25 post entry fee per horse/ rider combination. NO EXCEPTIONS

7. Food will be available on the grounds; lunch break will be announced 8. Please call to reserve a preferred parking spot for your trailer! 9. Champion & Reserve will be awarded for Easy Does It; Pony Hunter, Schooling Hunter, Special Hunter, Short Stirrup Hunter, Children’s Hunter , Low Hunter based on points (no entry fees) 10. Positively no refunds without certificate from medical doctor or veterinarian. 11. Class 1 Hi-Lo, horse/ rider combination one round at desired height judged on performance and soundness 12. Class 17 W-T Equit. (11 & over) to be conducted and judged the same as class 13. 13. Class 18 W-T Pleas. (11 & over) to be conducted and judged the same as class 15. 14. Class 9 & 35 Hunter Derby Open to horse/pony rider combinations who entered at least two jumping classes at this show. A two round hunter classic over fences. Round one competitors must jump a 10 fence course. Course may include option fence, in and out, bending line and unrelated distance. Judged on hunter style, soundness, quality, movement and brilliance of pace. Round two Top 8 riders will return in reverse order to jump a handy hunter round which will include at least two of the following: trot jump, tight turn option, halt and/or back and hand gallop a fence. Judged on handiness, style, and brilliance. Entry Fee \$20 (six entries required to run this class)

Downeast Medal Specifications: Contestants required to perform over a minimum of 8 (4 walk-trot) fences with at least one change of direction. 25% will be called for individual testing. 3 must complete the course to count. - Walk-Trot Poles Medal - Riders 14 & under. Trot minimum 4 poles. Verbal testing encouraged. -- Mini Medal - Riders 17 & under, horses/ponies. Must not have shown over 2’3” 18” tests 1-8 -- Children’s Medal - Riders 17 & under on horses or ponies. Fences 2’3” (tests 1-8) -- Junior Medal - Riders 17 & under on horses. Fences not to exceed 2’9” (tests 1-19) -- Modified Adult Medal - Amateurs 18 and over. Fences not to exceed 2’3” (tests 1-8) -- Adult Medal - Amateurs -- Pony Medal - riders 17 & under. sm/med 2’3” large 2’6” (tests 1-19) --Pony Medal - riders 17 & under. sm/med 2’3” large 2’6” (tests 1-19)
